Accident and Emergency (A&E) and the 999 ambulance service should only be used in real emergencies. As A&E can get very busy it is good to know the alternative services which are available.

NHS 111

NHS 111 is a new service that's being introduced to make it easier for you to access local NHS healthcare services. You can call 111 when you need medical help fast but it's not a 999 emergency. NHS 111 is a fast and easy way to get the right help, whatever the time.

NHS Walk In Centres, Minor Injury Units, and Urgent Care Centres

Choose Walk In Centres, Minor Injury Units and Urgent Care Centres, when you have a health problem that isn't a 999 emergency. You don't need an appointment to visit and you'l be seen in priority order by a doctor or experienced nurse. (Details of Local Walk In Centres and Minor Injury Units are supplied inside this leaflet)

Walk In Centres can be the best option for treatment and/or providing advice on

- Headaches, ear problems and sore throats
- **Q** Sprains and strains
- Wound infections
- Minor burns and scalds
- Minor head injuries
- **Skin** conditions
- Chest problems and abdominal pain
- Insect and animal bites
- Minor eye injuries
- Injuries to the back, shoulder and chest
- Emergency contraception
- Minor Surgery

(Please note, not all treatments/services listed will be available in every NHS Walk In Centre)
